Koehler Honored by International Association

BLOOMINGTON, Ill. — Wade Koehler, director of conferences and facilities use at Illinois Wesleyan University, has been awarded the Outstanding Individual Achievement Award from the Association of Collegiate Conference and Events Directors, International.

The award was announced at the organization's annual meeting last month in Vancouver, British Columbia.

Koehler joined the Illinois Wesleyan staff in 2001 and has established a centralized scheduling department and has also reorganized the University's Main Desk phone system. In addition, he has been instrumental in bringing several new conferences to the campus and in organizing the University's summer conference program.

In presenting the award to Koehler, officials of the organization cited him for "his ability to make significant changes during his short tenure" and for the way in which he has made "positive changes in all areas that he touches."

In addition to receiving the award, Koehler chaired a panel entitled Small College Conference Operations during the conference.
