BLOOMINGTON, ILL.--Four Illinois Wesleyan University faculty members have been appointed to new positions of administration, University Provost Ellen S. Hurwitz announced today.

Beginning June 1, Donna Hartweg will serve as the acting director of the School of Nursing. A doctoral student at Wayne State University, Hartweg, 1608 E. Washington, is an associate professor of who joined the faculty in 1978. She received her BSN degree from the University of Iowa, a master's in education from Illinois State University and a master's degree from the University of Illinois.

In a move effective Aug. 1, David Baily was named director of the natural science division, Patricia Klingenberg was appointed to head the foreign language department and Timothy Rettich will head the chemistry department.

Baily, professor of chemistry, 719 Angela Dr., Normal, has been at Wesleyan since 1980. He received his bachelor's degree from Juniata College and his doctorate from Massachusetts Institute of Technology.

Klingenberg, assistant professor of Spanish, 1205 E. Jefferson, came to Wesleyan in 1987. She received her bachelor's, master's and doctorate degrees from the University of Illinois.

Rettich, associate professor of chemistry, 1821 E. Lafayette, joined the Wesleyan faculty in 1981. A graduate of the University of Dayton, he received his doctorate degree from Case Western Reserve University and has served as acting chairperson of the department for the past year.
