BLOOMINGTON, ILL.--Dr. Tom Streeter, director of jazz programs at Illinois Wesleyan University, will be guest conductor of the New Mexico All State Jazz Band Dec. 1-2 in Las Cruces, NM. Streeter also will be featured soloist with the New Mexico State Jazz Ensemble Nov. 30 at a concert in Mexico and later at the University.

Streeter organized a jazz program at Wesleyan when he joined the faculty in 1971. A graduate of Indiana University, he holds a Doctor of Musical Arts degree from Catholic University, Washington, DC. He is a former member of the U.S. Air Force jazz ensemble, Airmen of Note, and has played for a number of celebrities in Las Vegas house bands.
