BLOOMINGTON, Ill.-- Interpretive dancer Randall Bane will perform his original work, *The Word of God in Motion*, at Evelyn Chapel Wednesday, Nov. 16 at 11 a.m. Admission is free and open to the public.

Bane has been featured as a performer and teacher at the Christian Artists Music Seminar in Colorado, and its European counterpart at De Bron in Holland. Bane has toured with Adrian Snell and his musical *Alpha & Omega*, and directed dance productions of Steve Fry's musical *We are Called*, which was staged in Singapore and the Philippines. He has made six tours in Australia and ministered in Eastern Europe, as well as Western Europe.

Since 1983, Bane has been a dance soloist at the Christian Celebration of the Feast of Tabernacles in Jerusalem, serving as Director of Dance and Drama for that celebration from 1984 to the present. Previously he has presented *The Word of God in Motion* at the Edinburgh Festival and at the Fortune Theatre in London's West End.

Bane trained and has performed as an actor in New York City, spending two years there with Theatre Genesis, working on experimental and avante garde plays. Bane also worked as stage manager for the New York University School of Drama. He holds a bachelor of arts degree in theatre, and master of science degree in therapeutic recreation from the University of Missouri, Columbia. Bane is a founder of the Gallery Theatre in St. Louis, Mo.
