BLOOMINGTON, Illinois — Baccalaureate degrees were conferred on 416 members of the Class of 1995 at Illinois Wesleyan University Saturday, May 20, during the 145th annual Commencement program.

President Minor Myers, jr., also conferred an honorary Doctor of Humane Letters degree on Dawn Upshaw, who delivered the Commencement address. Upshaw is a two-time Grammy Award-winning soprano and has been on the roster of New York's famed Metropolitan Opera since 1984.

Fourteen students graduated summa cum laude (S), signifying a grade point average of 3.9 or higher on a scale of 4.0; 39 received magna cum laude honors (M) for a GPA of 3.7 or higher, and 54 graduated cum laude (C) for a GPA of 3.5 or higher.

A total of 394 received Bachelor of Arts (BA) degrees; 25 were presented Bachelor of Science (BS) degrees; 47 received Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degrees; 53 graduated with Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA) degrees--nine in art, 15 in theatre arts and four in music theatre; 15 received Bachelor of Music (BM) degrees; and 10 received Bachelor of Music Education (BME) degrees.
