Artists'**Backgrounds:**

Sparagana received a master of fine arts degree from Stanford University. He is a prolific painter, who has exhibited across the United States, including New York, Illinois, and Texas. His work has appeared in magazines such as *Art in America*. Sparagana has received several fellowships and grants, including one from Cite Internationale des Arts, Paris, France. He is an associate professor of art at Rice University in Houston, Texas.

Kahn received a master of fine arts degree from Yale University. She is a painter and printmaker. Kahn's works have been exhibited throughout the United States, including Texas, Illinois, Massachusetts, and California. She has given

several guest lectures at galleries and universities. Kahn is an assistant professor of art at Northern Illinois University in DeKalb.

Walters received a master of arts degree from Iowa State University and a master of fine arts degree from Bradley University. A versatile artist and educator, Walters recently received a \$1,000 Qualex Corp. award in the Photography and Digital Image Biennial Exhibition at East Carolina University. He has received research grants and a grant from the Iowa Arts Council to photograph vanishing elements of rural Iowa. Walters' recent work combines his expertise in photography, digital manipulation, and miniature architectural construction to create artistic dwellings.
