A flowering pink crab apple tree was planted on the campus of Illinois Wesleyan University Tuesday afternoon to honor the memory of Jean Kuhle Brandt, IWU '46, past president of the Alumni Association who died July 7.

Planted near the northeast entrance of Memorial Student Center, the tree was the gift of Donna Dodge Bischoff, IWU '48, Greeley, Colo., close friend and sorority sister of Mrs. Brandt.

Mrs. Brandt's husband, William, a university trustee, participated in the brief ceremony which was attended by members of the Board of Trustees, including new members Rev. Chester Sheldon and Mrs. Helen Goldsworthy.
