Miles Bair, Director of the School of Art at Illinois Wesleyan University, will present an exhibition of some of his latest work Jan. 7-23 in the Wakeley Gallery.

Bair used acrylic and enamel paints on masonite panels for the exhibition, which will consist of 10 small scale works based on a variety of midwestern themes.

A graduate of Edinboro State College, Edinboro, Pa., Bair holds a master's degree in education from his alma mater and a master's degree in art from West Virginia University. He came to Illinois Wesleyan in 1979 from the College of Saint Benedict, where he was chairperson of the art department for three years. Prior to that, he was acting coordinator of art education at West Virginia University (1975-76) and chairperson of the art department at Thiel College (1972-75).

Bair is one of three Wesleyan faculty members whose works are part of the first annual Central Illinois Arts Consortium Invitational Exhibition currently traveling throughout the state. That exhibition will be on display in the Merwin Gallery in April.
