"Suds City Sculpture," an invitational show of Milwaukee sculptors, is presently on exhibition in the Merwin Gallery at Illinois Wesleyan University.

The show will be open free to the public through Apr. 10 from 1-4 p.m. daily and 7-9 p.m. Tuesday. There also will be a slide presentation and reception at 7 p.m. Apr. 10 in room 218 of the art building.

The sculptors in the show are Carl Billinsley, John Hill, Charles Kraus, Narendra Patel, Ken Payne and Tom Uebelherr.

Starting Apr. 1 and running through Apr. 12 there will be an exhibition of work by the members of the art faculty at Lincoln College in the Wakeley Gallery in the art building.

The hours for the Wakeley Gallery are the same as the Merwin Gallery.

This show is part of a faculty exchange between the two schools. Illinois Wesleyan art faculty members presented a show at Lincoln College in February.

Exhibiting in the show will be Albert Wong, department chairman, four oil paintings; Martha Hargett, three pieces of woven wall hangings; Leola Dowling, four large water colors; Steve Mercer, extension program teacher, three silk screen prints; Alan Vaughn, extension program teacher, paintings; and David Schroeder, part-time instructor, color photographs.
