BLOOMINGTON, ILL.--Illinois Wesleyan University's Robert M. Montgomery Outstanding Young Alumnus Award will be presented to Dr. Toby C. Herzog, '68, assistant professor of English at Wabash College, Crawfordsville, Ind.

After graduating with honors from Wesleyan, Herzog became a Congressional liaison with the U.S. Army at Fort Gordon, Ga. He earned the Army Commendation Medal there and in 1969 won a Bronze Star in Vietnam where he was a personnel specialist.

Herzog holds master's and doctoral degrees from Purdue University and in 1976 joined the faculty at Wabash College, where he is co-chairman of the freshman tutorial program. In addition to his teaching duties, he serves on the faculties of two university summer programs, a 3-year liberal arts program of personal development for business executives and an intensive workshop for high school students studying the business world.

He has written many scholarly papers and other publications. He is a member of several scholarly and professional organizations and was named an Outstanding Young Man of America in 1980.

He now operates a part-time consulting service for business and industry, and frequent conducts writing seminars.

Herzog married Peggy Miller, IWU '67, a graduate of the School of Nursing. They are the parents of two sons, Robert, 9 and Joseph, 5.
