Anna Callorui-Holcombe, instructor in art at Illinois Wesleyan University, is among the artists included in the Chicago Vicinity Clay exhibition at the Lill Street Gallery in Chicago.

The show, which is funded in part by the Illinois Arts Council, opened Friday, Oct. 9, and will run through Oct. 31.

Two pieces from Ms. Holcombe's "ritualgames" series were selected by jurors Ruth Duckworth and Bill Kremmer. The jurors selected an exhibition of 80 pieces from the entries submitted by clay artists within a 150 mile radius of Chicago.
