

Members of the graduating class at Illinois Wesleyan University will wear their caps and gowns for the first time Wednesday, May 5, at the annual Honors Day Convocation.

The program, which will be at 11 a.m. in Presser Hall, will be dedicated to the seniors and to all students who have earned scholastic and activities recognition.

The speaker will be Dr. J. Robert Hippensteele, professor of biology. His topic will be "Stimulation, Perception and Vision."

Senior class president Ann Frank, Milledgeville will preside.

Dr. Robert S. Eckley, university president, will administer the oath of office to Julie Brewer, Beardstown, as President of the Student Senate.

Wesley Osborn, senior religion major from Cropsey, will deliver the invocation. He is a student local pastor of the Central Illinois District, United Methodist Church, who serves churches at Cropsey and Strawn. Julie Wells, Springfield, will deliver the benediction.

Organ majors Angela Naffziger, Zion, and Gary Beckmann, Germantown, will play the prelude and processional, and postlude and recessional, respectively.

An alumnus of Hampden-Sydney College, Hippensteele earned a doctorate in biophysics at the University of California. He came to Wesleyan in 1974 from Indiana University.
