BLOOMINGTON, IL-- Kirk Schroeder, the son of Harland and Sharon Schroeder of Rural Route #3, Watseka, is the first recipient of the Anderson Physics Scholarship at Illinois Wesleyan University.

Schroeder, a junior physics major, was present with his family September 8 as University President Robert S. Eckley announced the establishment of the scholarship at the annual Convocation ceremony.

Illinois Wesleyan alumnus and former trustee Scott Anderson is the founder of the fund, which will provide a full or partial tuition grant to a physics major of outstanding scholarship and character. Mr. Anderson, who graduated from Wesleyan in 1935, is founder and president of Anderson Physics Laboratories, Inc., Champaign. He earned master's and doctor's degrees from the University of Illinois.

A member of the Dean's List for academic excellence in each of his first four semesters, Schroeder has a cumulative grade point average of 3.944 on a 4.0 scale.

He is a member of Phi Gamma Delta fraternity, which he serves this year as rush chairman. He is also a member of Green Medallion, local activities honorary for sophomores. He graduated from Watseka Community High School in 1980.
