BLOOMINGTON, ILL.--An exhibit of paintings by Sandra Perlow of Wilmette will open at 7 p.m. Tuesday, Oct. 26, in the Merwin Gallery at Illinois Wesleyan University.

The show will be open free to the public from 1-4 p.m. daily and 7-9 p.m. Tuesdays through Nov. 30, except for the Thanksgiving recess period Nov. 24-28.

Ms. Perlow will attend an opening reception and will present a gallery talk about her work.

The artist holds a master of arts degree from the Illinois Institute of Design and a master of fine arts degree from the School of the Art Institute of Chicago, where she teaches. She also teaches at Columbia College, Chicago.

Affiliated with the Barbara Balkin Gallery in Chicago, Ms. Perlow has presented a one person show this year at the Nancy Lurie Gallery, Chicago. In past years she has exhibited at the Braustein-Quay Gallery, San Francisco; Barbara Toll Fine Arts Gallery, New York; Washington (D.C.) Women's Center; New Horizon in Painting and Sculpture, Chicago; and the 30th Illinois Invitational, Illinois State Museum, Springfield.
