Dr. Thomas Streeter, associate professor of brass instruments and theory at Illinois Wesleyan University, will conduct a clinic for outstanding high school trombonists in the Chicago area from 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. Tuesday, Nov. 16, at Naperville North High School.
