BLOOMINGTON, ILL.--Illinois Central College art professor Fred Hentchel will open a one-man show Monday, Jan. 10, in the Wakeley Gallery at Illinois Wesleyan University.

The show, which will run through Jan. 26, will be open free to the public from 1-4 p.m. daily and 7-9 p.m. Tuesdays.

The exhibit will include paintings, collages and drawings.

Hentchel, a master's graduate of Bradley University, has been on the faculty at ICC since 1975. He has exhibited at the Heart of Illinois Art Show for the past five years.

Also in 1982 his work was part of the third annual Central Illinois Arts Consortium traveling exhibit, the S.P.A.R. National Exhibition, Shreveport, La., and shows at Black Hawk and Blackburn colleges, and Peoria Art Guild plus a faculty show at ICC.
