BLOOMINGTON, ILL.--David Nott, bass-baritone, will honor Johannes Brahms in his faculty recital at 8 p.m. Sunday, Mar. 6, in Westbrook Auditorium of Presser Hall.

The program, which will commemorate the sesquicentennial (150th) anniversary of his birth, will be open free to the public.

Nott will sing "Sieben vermischte Lieder," "Vier Ernste Gesaenge, Op. 121" and "Die Neue Liebeslieder Walzer, Op. 65."

He will be assisted by Dwight Drexler, piano; Susan Brandon and Bedford Watkins, duo-piano; Deborah Benerdot, soprano; Anne Nott, alto; and Sammy Scifres, tenor.

Nott, professor of voice and choral music, holds a doctorate from the College Conservatory of Music, University of Cincinnati. He came to Wesleyan in 1964 from Simpson College.
