BLOOMINGTON, ILL.--The president of the senior class at Illinois Wesleyan University, Jon. L. Simkins, Glenshaw, Pa., will preside at the annual Honors Day Convocation at 11 a.m. Wednesday, May 4, in Presser Hall.

The program will be dedicated to the seniors and to students from all classes who have earned scholastic and activities recognition.

Dr. Robert Bray, associate professor of English and chairman of the department, will be the principal speaker. His topic will be "Distilling the Universal from the Local."

Bray's latest book, "Rediscoveries: Literature and Place in Illinois," published last year by the University of Illinois Press, is an analysis and exploration of the work of several nineteenth century Illinois authors.

Dr. Margaret Chapman, assistant professor of economics, will recognize students from all four classes who have been elected to Phi Kappa Phi, national scholastic honorary.

A faculty instrumental quartet will play "Trio-Sonata in C Minor " by Quantz. The ensemble will include William West, flute; Jill West, oboe; Bedford Watkins, harpsichord; and John McGrosso, cello.

Gregory Jewison, Batavia, will deliver the invocation. Lynn Klumb, Wauwatosa, Wis., will deliver the benediction. Lisa Lawrence, Western Springs, will play the organ prelude, processional and recessional. All are seniors.
