A leadership conference of presidents of 22 districts of the Illinois Nurses Association will be held Saturday in Memorial Student Center of Illinois Wesleyan University, starting at 9:30 a.m. and continuing until 4:30 p.m.

It is the first such type of program sponsored by the INA, said Illinois Wesleyan faculty member Donna Hartweg, who is co-ordinating local arrangements. She is the president of District 22, which is made up of members in McLean, Livingston, Logan, DeWitt and Ford counties.

The aim of the program, Ms. Hartweg said, is to help participants develop leadership skills, and increase their knowledge of state and national organization structures.

The speakers will include Jo Anne Page of Chicago, INA president; Maribeth Badura of Chicago, INA secretary and past president of the Chicago Nurses Association; and Mickey Beil of Springfield, the INA Associate Administrator for Governmental Relations, and Elaine Beletz of Chicago, a member of the American Nurses Association board of directors.

The last session will divide the participants into small groups for problem-solving workshops.
