BLOOMINGTON, ILL.--Dr. Campbell Evans, Champaign resident who is the Adlai H. Rust Distinguished Professor of Insurance at Illinois Wesleyan University, was recognized Monday night by the American Institute of the Society for Chartered Property and Casualty Underwriters for 25 years of teaching CPCU courses.

Evans received a plaque and silver bowl at the dinner meeting of the Central Illinois CPCU chapter here.

Evans, who was a member of the University of Illinois faculty from 1961 to 1968, started teaching the CPCU courses in 1958 and continued to do so after joining the IWU faculty in 1968. He has owned his own insurance and appraisal agency in Champaign since 1946.

He received three degrees from the University of Illinois--bachelor of science in 1949, master of science in 1961 and a doctorate in 1966.

He and his wife, Mary, reside at 1602 Mayfair Rd., Champaign. Evans commutes to Wesleyan for his teaching duties.
