Three members of the Illinois Wesleyan University faculty will be on the program for the 12th annual 20th Century Literary Conference in Louisville, Ky., Wednesday through Saturday (Feb. 22-25).

Dr. Karen L. Osborne, assistant professor of English, will present a paper, "Fair Means or Foul: Alice Walker and the Politics of Revenge." Walker was the first black woman novelist to win a Pulitzer prize. She was the 1983 recipient for her novel, The Color Purple.

Dr. Salvador J. Fajardo, associate professor of Spanish, will chair a session entitled "Political Protests: Dictatorships in the Spanish-American Novel."

Dr. John Engle, assistant professor of English, will read his paper, "Politics and the Ulster Poet."

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
