Dr. George A. Churukian, director of the teacher education program at Illinois Wesleyan University, will be on the program for the Fourth International Seminar on Teacher Education to be held in Roehampton, Surrey, England, Apr. 11-20.

Churukian, who has conducted a survey of participants concerning directions the organization should take in the future, will lead a discussion of the survey on Apr. 14 and later offer a closing report based on the discussions. The theme for the conference is "Priorities for Teacher Education in the 1980s and 1990s."

The invitational event already includes participants from 21 nations among its 60 registrants. About 100 persons are expected to take part.

Roehampton is a few miles southeast of London. The seminar is being hosted by North East London Polytechnical College on the campus of Digby Stewart College.
