BLOOMINGTON, ILL.--Dr. Cheryln Bradley, Broadview, and Flora Harris "Flo" Armstrong, 106 N. Bellemont, Illinois Wesleyan University alumnae from the classes of 1973 and 1943, respectively, will enjoy places of honor during the annual Homecoming celebration Saturday, Oct. 26.

Bradley will be presented the Robert S. Montgomery Outstanding Young Alumna Award. She will ride in the parade and receive a plaque during ceremonies prior to the 1:30 p.m. football game against Carroll in Wesleyan Stadium.

A research chemist for the Amoco Corporation in Naperville, Bradley analyzes certain compounds in petroleum, petrochemicals and synfuels. She is a liaison and consultant on contaminants in refinery products.

She also is a director of the Chicago section of the American Chemical Society and is a member of the American Society for Testing and Materials, serving on committees on chromatography and petroleum products and lubricants.

Bradley graduated magna cum laude. The chemistry department faculty and senior chemistry majors voted her the Mortimer Merit Award in 1973, an award established by IWU trustee emeritus Dr. Harold C. Hodge, '25 who is a member of the IWU Science Advisory Committee.

Flo Armstrong was selected by a committee of students to be Grand Marshal of the Homecoming Parade because she is one of the University's most dedicated alumni.

She has been a university trustee since 1977. From 1975-77 she was president of the Century Club and in 1980 she joined the President's Club board. She served as class agent for eight years and for the past seven years has been a chairman and a volunteer for the phonothon. She is a member of the steering committee of the Alumni Campaign for Endowment, serves as co-chairman with her husband, Victor Armstrong Sr., for the swimming pool fund raising campaign and was a sponsor of Evelyn Chapel.
