

Dr. Donald L. Strand, professor of insurance at Illinois Wesleyan University, is one of 25 college and university professors who have been invited to attend the annual meeting of the Society of Chartered Property and Casualty Underwriters in Atlanta, Ga., Sept. 28-Oct. 1.

The visiting faculty members will be guests of the Society of CPCU and the Harry J. Loman Foundation in a jointly-sponsored pilot program designed to benefit both professional educators and their students. Each of the CPCU society's 138 chapters was asked to nominate a full-time teacher of property and casualty insurance or risk management courses.

"This is a unique occasion for the Society since our annual seminars are usually restricted to CPCUs," said Society President James L. Jerden. "We will benefit from having these leading educators as our guests by seeking their input about our seminar content and presentation. If this pilot program provides the kind of synergism we feel it will, we hope the concept can be expanded in the future."

Strand, who holds the CPCU designation, joined the IWU faculty in 1968. He holds bachelor, masters and doctoral degrees from the University of Minnesota and is a former member of the Bradley University faculty.
