BLOOMINGTON, ILL. -- Don Lamb, senior man atics and physics major at Illinois Wesleyan University, is the Ancer Physics Scholar for the current school year, it was announced Wedness during the annual President's Convocation.

In making the announcement, Dr. Wayne roon, president of the university, said he is the fourth recipient he scholarship which was established in 1982.

Anderson, who is president and founder Anderson Physics Laboratories Inc., Champaign, earned master's and doctor agrees at the University of Illinois. He served as president of the IVI amni Associaton in 1956-57 and was a trustee from 1958-76. He received honorary degree from Wesleyan in 1960 and was honored as Distingue and Alumnus in 1980.
