BLOOMINGTON, ILL.--Don Lamb, senior mathematics and physics major at Illinois Wesleyan University, is the Anderson Physics Scholar for the current school year, it was announced Wednesday during the annual President's Convocation.

In making the announcement, Dr. Wayne E. Larson, president of the university, said he is the fourth recipient of the scholarship which was established in 1982.

Established by 1935 alumnus and trustee Emeritus Scott Anderson, the scholarship provides full or partial tuition for a student of outstanding scholarship and character.

Lamb qualifies with a record of having been on the Dean's List for academic excellence every semester since enrolling at Wesleyan. The Dean's List requires a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.5 on a scale of 4.0.

Lamb is a member of Phi Kappa Phi, national scholastic honorary; the Intervarsity Christian Fellowship; and Student Interested in Natural Science.

Anderson, who is president and founder of Anderson Physics Laboratories Inc., Champaign, earned master's and doctor's degrees at the University of Illinois. He served as president of the IWC Alumni Association in 1956-57 and was a trustee from 1958-76. He received an honorary degree from Wesleyan in 1960 and was honored as Distinguished Alumnus in 1980. He is a member of the President's Club, Board of Visitors and Science Advisory Committee.
