BLOOMINGTON, ILL.--Pianist Lawrence Campbell, assistant professor of piano at Illinois Wesleyan University, will present a recital at 8 p.m. Sunday, Nov. 16, in Westbrook Auditorium of Presser Hall.

The program, which will be open free to the public, will celebrate the centennial of the death of Franz Liszt.

Campbell will open the program with a Liszt arrangement for piano of Bach's "Prelude and Fugue for Organ in A Minor, .543." He also will play three movements from "Annees de Pelerinage," the andante, capriccioso, the theme and variations from "Grandes Etudes de Paganini," and "Sonata in B Minor (1853)."

The recitalist has presented lecture-recitals of Liszt's music throughout the midwest during this centennial year.
