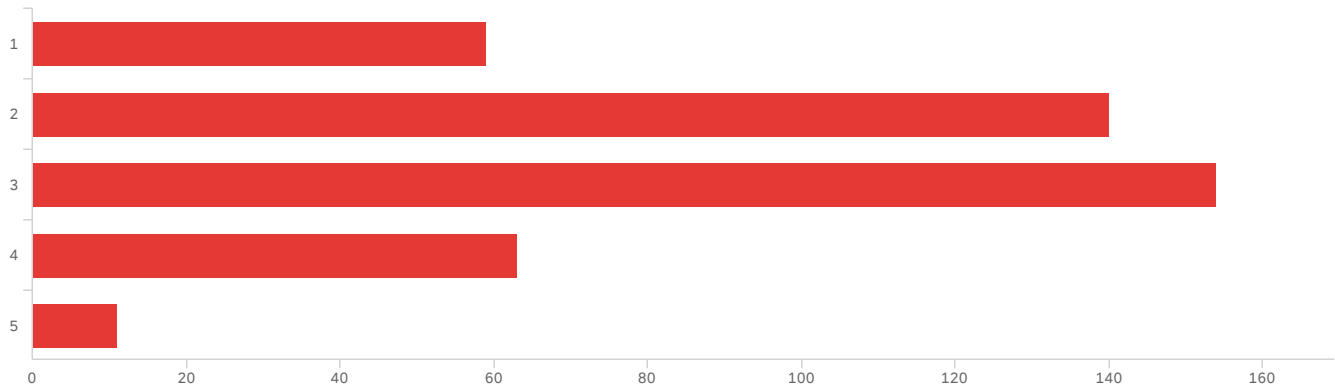

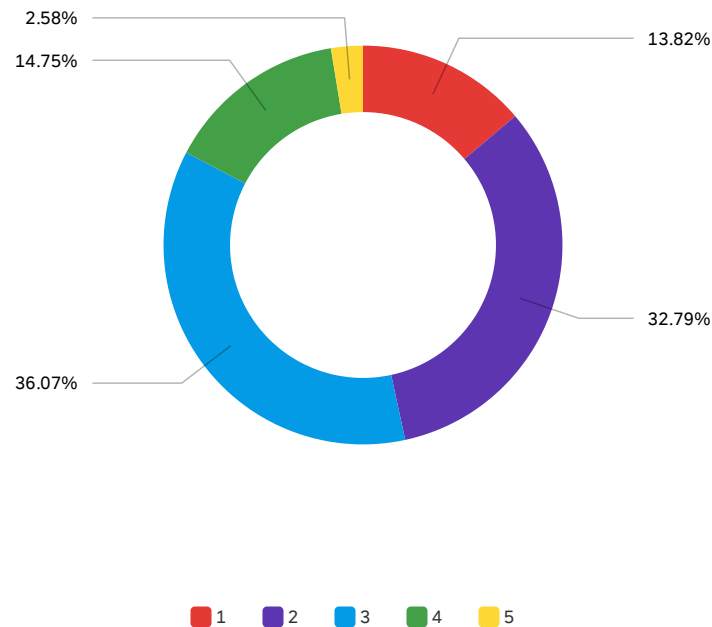

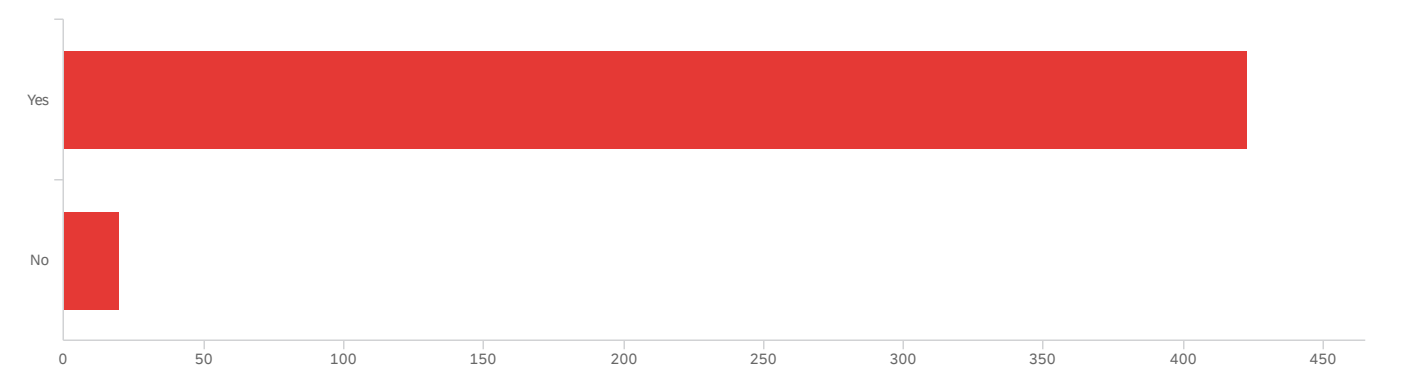
Q2 - How are you feeling about the first few days of distance learning?

I appreciate it but I don't think IWU can fix my internet access problems

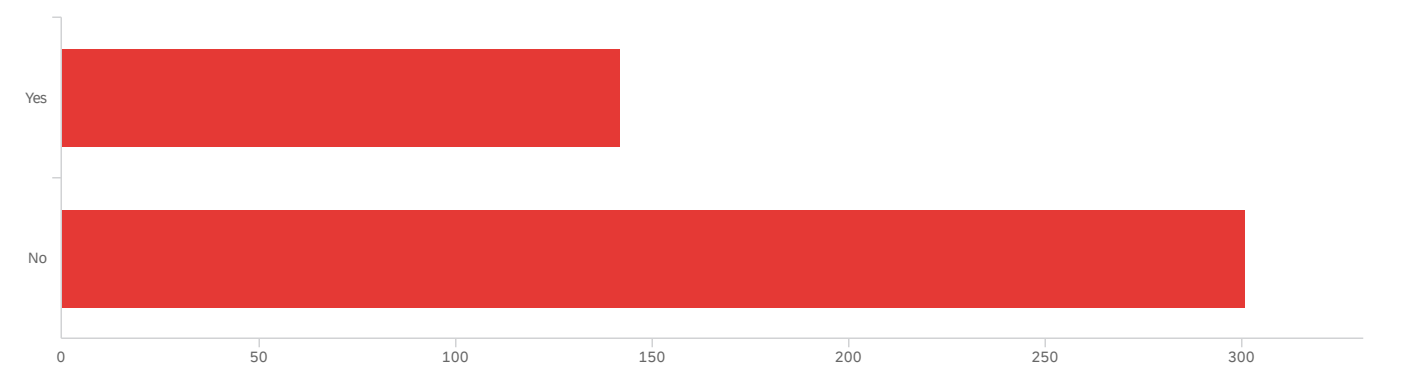
Sometimes I need VPN to access gmail and google classroom

I have a performance based major, and this is incredibly difficult to do away from others.

There is a lot of stress surrounding the pandemic right now, on top of other stressors. My academic workload proves to be very heavy and overwhelming, especially when at home during this time.

Accommodations are hard to maintain in a home environment

There are 4 of us distance learning and working at one time, this makes internet connection slow and ability in general less

It's not anyone's fault; arts majors just really cannot work online, so a lot of our class activities were impossible.

Different time zone

The only issue is that with the rest of my family teaching/working from home sometimes my internet cuts out and I am automatically kicked out of calls (like Google Hangouts). Other than that though its been great!

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Another sibling doing online classes with one computer available.

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Focus is more difficult with online because of the setting and essence of the class. Being in a classroom setting allows me to be more alert and aware of what is happening, and I have a physical board to visualize things on. Professors are teaching from home as well, and it takes away their ability to represent the discussion in a visual sense. It's also difficult to work in a home environment. My brain is not used to this setting and although I am doing my work, I've noticed it's just more difficult overall to focus.

Can't go back to my home state, can't stay in IL, I am a stressed vagabond.

My living situation is unstable, and the stress of having family members, extended family members, and friends who are high risk is pretty severe.

I left some of my notes at IWU and am not allowed back in the building to retrieve them.

Hard to concentrate from Home

Not having a dedicated space for studying/participating in online classes/whole family being home

Being home all day my family makes it difficult to study. Schedule class time, test, and assignments are difficult manage during my day

The global pandemic makes it hard to concentrate or find worth in writing an essay. The lack of access to a library and the resources in the library that I use to do my work, I was doing archival work and now I can't. And it's been suggested that I take an incomplete and finish it when this ends, but I don't want to delay the rest of my life.

I can not print out materials from computers...

Being at home there are other responsibilities I have to manage so scheduling is ultimately different!

My internet sucks so it only works some of the time

My living situation is unstable, I moved and probably will again.

Basically the connection is always terrible, I can perceive like 50 percent of the material (generous estimate) and its not feasible to learn. Also being that every website everywhere especially the platforms used by the school are posting COVID banners everywhere making the anxiety worse. I've never felt more overwhelmed by workload anxiety and stress in my life. I receive 12 emails a day on average from professors basically explaining how behind I am and I am trying my hardest to stay updated. How do you expect your students to function under high stress schoolwork plus this pandemic when people like me are isolated from family and don't know if our grandmothers in the nursing homes are die in this pandemic and I wont be able to say goodbye. Ive spent many nights up until late hours just to stay afloat only to wake up to an incomprehensible poorly connected 8am lecture M,W,F.

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Most professors are trying to teach as if we are still in person and it does not work

Being at home, it's difficult to get onto a routine. I'm not as productive, my schedules are all jumbled up, and my motivation to learn is the lowest it's been in years.

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Professors unwilling to admit that students are going through emotional labor as well as educational.

It's just difficult to focus and get things done. I am also struggling to keep myself motivated. I find myself feeling anxious and sad more often.

A quiet place to work.

Disability/Family life

My parents... I live in a tiny apartment so I hear every single noise. It's very distracting since everyone is home all the time

It is just very hard for me to just work at home because it is hard for me to focus at home so it is taking me 10 times longer to get my assignments done. And some of my professors have me checking three platforms in order to get information from them and it is just easier to meet in class, but we do not have that right now. I just feel like I am not learning as much at home and I feel like this ending to the year is basically a waste since I cannot focus in my own home.

WiFi in town is overloaded by everyone working from home, so sometimes it doesn't work.

Unreliable WiFi

Having to work now a bit more at my job to be able to provide for my family

There is no quiet place for me to do my work.

My home environment is not very conducive to a calm/quiet learning environment

It is really hard to get things done at home. There isn't a good work space and it is VERY difficult to keep track of everything I'm expected to do. I live in a small house with both of my parents and two siblings that are also expected to do online learning and I do not have any space that is my own for studying. I am staying up so late at night because it is the only time when it is quiet. I don't have reliable internet and I'm just very worried that my grades will slip and this will cause me to not graduate. I'm also very sad about how my senior year is ending.

My house is having construction done on it so it is very loud and sometimes hard to hear

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Internet access is very spotty. It's even worse with my siblings and parents having to work from home, as well.

My grandma is on life support and it's difficult to split time between trying to see/talk with her and doing my coursework. My work study is also obviously gone, so I'm trying to find work since my regular job in town is considered non essential and not hiring me back. I'm worried that if my grandma passes, it will be difficult to finish the rest of this semester given the already trying academic circumstances.

My parents are struggling financially because of the obstacles they are facing with the current pandemic. I am working full time at a nursing home to help them financially, exposing myself every day to the virus. Because I am working, there are certain online lectures I can't attend. I am being put in the situation where I am supposed to choose between supporting my family and devoting myself to education. I hope the administration is considering problems like this, as I am a low-income first generation American and college student, and the circumstances which I am living under are preventing me from being as invested. I have a work study on campus and am compensating for both my wages and that of my family's. Please recognize that there are students working on the front lines right now-- fast food, grocery stores, and assisting with high-risk individuals.

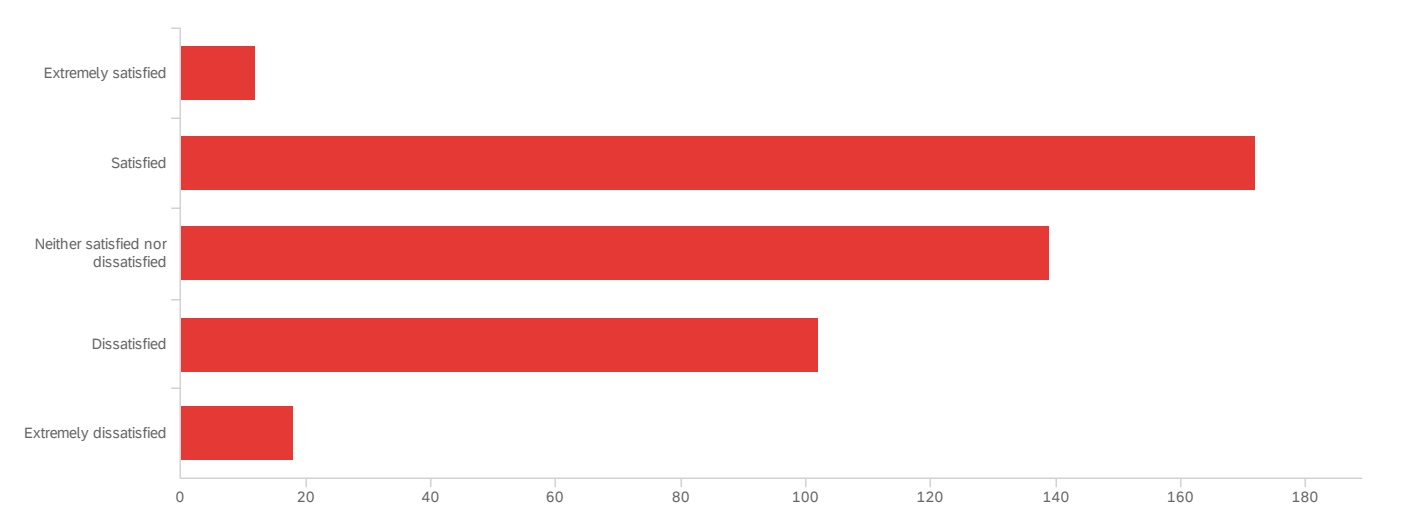

What about the instructional methods is less than satisfying?

Online learning is not as effective as in person classes for me.

Its hard to understand, let's say math, without being able to see the problems being worked out

I have just never learned well online and prefer face to face interaction.

Trying to read the white board that the teacher is writing on. The camera is blurry in and out which makes it difficult to read.

It's very informal and results in an informal atmosphere and less dedication to the work produced.

busy work

The lagging, talking over each other, not being able to hear when someone else is talking. These problems would happen with any technology, though

I just wish I was in the classroom. Its really hard for me to work because of the distractions around me. Since none of my classes are actually meeting face-to-face, its hard to find the motivation to do things.

It's very difficult to focus in an environment where there can be so many distractions. Plus, it hurts my eyes after hours of doing online learning on my laptop. However, I understand this is what needs to be done in order for us to continue school.

Organization, there's so much to juggle with every class that it's hard to know exactly what is due

I always prefer face-to-face instruction methods over online, but in this case that isn't available.

Doing your own classes by yourself and then having to do the homework is very challenging for a first year student. We are still trying to or have just grasped the idea of what college is about and now we have to learn a whole new method from home. There isn't much you can do about it but it is very challenging and hard to wrap your head around.

Email communications. I am not experienced in Microsoft Word and my professor expected me to be, and so I incorrectly did an assignment and he gave me a poor grade. He did not tell me how to do this assignment, yet I was punished for it.

I am a visual learner and its difficult to have to look off of multiple tabs with notes taking up half the screen and the video/presentation taking up the other half. Having physical copies of notes would make it much easier so that I could type additional notes on a google doc or open excel for my finance class for example. It's hard to follow along with a teacher when I can't do that they're doing at the same time; it's difficult to follow along and remember.

Online meetings are ineffective and laughable. Nothing gets done.

Should be all pass/fail

With being in education our teachers have no care for what else is going on in our lives. classes never end on time and actually have more assignments than our already full class load

I'm not able to get the hands-on instruction that I'm used to.

Some of the moodle page updates are hard to understand and there are almost too many emails being sent out.

Having classes that do not have any virtual meetings that only post reading to learn the material.

I am not in class to learn the material and it seems a bit pointless

Not having access to office hours or other resources available ON CAMPUS

It's just not the same as being as school, it's not easy to concentrate and actually learn in this type of setting. Procrastinating is way to easy when you don't have tk face the teacher in class.

Professors are still lecturing how they would in person but without break for students to ask questions and without realizing that because students are cooped up all day in their home, having classes at home means there's less of an attention span

not being in a classroom

It's really hard to replicate in-person class sessions where professors can draw and write on whiteboards as well as give their typical lecture. This can be especially difficult for courses like Models of Computing where we are constantly drawing out complex machines along with writing lengthy proofs. It does not translate very well through online instruction.

Yes

There are too many communication spaces. Every teacher is doing something different, and as someone with ADHD and Autism, it is VERY difficult to keep track of everything.

Some of the professors are very confusing and completely change all the plans that we had originally planned when we learned about distance learning.

The amount of homework being assigned still and the loud interruptions other students cause from their home connection in Google Hangouts

We are reading through the powerpoints and labs are not the same

I just miss my in person classes

Professors are not recording voices or doing live lectures so comprehending all the material in emails makes learning more difficult.

For video classes not much information is shared, there is no benefit of having to log in to a video

We, along with professors, were not given very much time to the new methods and were just thrown into this with no real prior knowledge or communication. The school relied to heavily on the professors themselves and did not do a sufficient job preparing the student body as a whole; every professor, every class is doing something completely different and that's disorienting and messy for every student right now.

Nothing really wrong with them, I just miss being on campus and having human contact

Cramming in big project one after another is very difficult to allocate now. As well, exams are taking place during my regularly scheduled work hours.

In some courses it still isn't clear what we are doing

Clarification methods aren't good

In order to ask questions about material for classes that don't have video chats together, you have to set up an appointment to have a meeting with the prof. in office hrs over video call or email them. Takes longer for a specific question to get answered.

constant changes in expectations and projects, only one of my professors is holding Zoom lectures

Sometimes tough to understand because I am a visual learner and can easily learn by watching the professor do the work but at home that doesn't happen

I don't feel like I am absorbing the material as well because I am more distracted.

The professors are doing their best and I appreciate the effort, but it still seems like admin was woefully unprepared compared to other universities. It still feels like admin is behind the curve in terms of other policies (pass/fail, which took a while to initiate vs other universities which had it weeks ago, widespread use of zoom vs google hangouts). Effort from professors has been great though.

Very confusing. I'd rather my professors email me a clear list of assignments so I know exactly what I need to do when they need to be done

They are not in person

There are lags sometimes with online Zoom.

Not as structured as before

Zoom, google meet, FaceTime

It doesn't work with my major

I have a couple courses where I have very limited input from my professor as in they just send the notes for the day and that's it. No video presentation or live class. Yes they are available via email to answer questions, but I just don't feel connected or engaged with them by this method.

Online classes are choppy, they lag, I cannot ask relevant questions, or at least it takes much more effort to do so, and seems like a chore.

Slow responses to emails, scattered assignments, unorganized

I have a lab that I was attending 2 times a week for the full slotted time that is now comprised of watching two movies. I don't know that I am getting everything I should/need to from this course especially for how much I paid for it.

Professors are unable to stay organized as this transition happens and there are a lot of assignments and exams that are unclear to the students. When we receive 10+ emails a day from professors it gets overwhelming and we don't all understand what is expected of us

Having a class period that I was expected to attend helped me better engage the material, online videos get boring and I lose interest easily. Its much more difficult to make myself sit down and do the work needed while at home with other distractions and daily chores.

Honestly, my professors are using the online learning materials to the fullest, but I'm just very disappointed to not have the in-person experience, and the awkwardness and impersonal feelings that arise from only using online amplify that.

Harder when not in person.

What about the instructional methods is less than satisfying?

Several professors of mine (understandably) are considerably thrown off about the pandemic. There's not much teaching going on. Just discussing the things we already know.

Two of my classes which were very discussion based courses have basically turned into here is all the work you need to do send it in on Moodle. So there really is no more participation in class activities because there are none. And as someone who cannot simply just read a chapter or book and fully understand every concept to its fullest I say I'm being very challenged.

It's seems just to be busy work and I don't feel I'm learning at the same rate

Not hands on but understand the circumstances

The fact that students aren't getting a chance to adjust before we have to dive back into courses. I

Not the same

For a discussion based class the instructional method used for a class debate was email where students had to continually refresh their inboxes in order to respond and were often behind in the conversation due to it

Asking and answering questions during a class

I am most anxious about writing papers, I know the writing center is still kind of open? I can still make appointments? But I am not confident in my writing skills when I'm on campus so I'm definitely anxious about writing one off campus

Professor email us inform, instead posting the info on moodle.

Lessons feel redundant and unnecessary. Also, the recorded lessons are far too long to be engaging, especially when the class was meant to be discussion based. These things are especially true in instruction from Diana Jaher

Professors who didn't adapt their plans to fit with eLearning. Specifically keeping group projects and presentations in the schedule when it is nearly impossible to do them well with online learning.

There's no good way to show video, so some professors are making us watch it on our own time which is an extra burden, while others try to show it in class but it's so glitchy that it's very difficult to understand what is happening. Also we lost a week in the semester but everyone is ignoring that and still moving full speed ahead, of not adding more assignments on top of what we already have.

course schedule changes all the sudden that I need to spend a lot of time adjusting to it.

just getting sent documents to read and then basically just teaching myself

It's very confusing because each teacher wants a different thing and I'm constantly checking my emails and have all these questions

Scheduled class meetings are useless and unproductive. People don't take them seriously. We get nothing done. The time is inconvenient. Just record your lecture and be done with it. Don't have online class meetings with 40+ distracted people, because that doesn't work for anyone

I would say that google meet is very glitchy and it is hard to feel like a class when you can only see like 5 people. Zoom appears to be much better

Just difficult to learn, I didn't sign up for online classes because I can't learn as well as I can with in person classes

It's a difficult situation and everyone is doing their best but it's not the same

What about the instructional methods is less than satisfying?

poor connection, poor communication, unfeasible timelines and expectations, the constant stress of getting a dozen of emails daily with unrelated content, today I couldn't get into a lecture, Most of my lectures have also been going 15 minutes over time

the fact that this is even happening and that classes have neither been postponed nor canceled. my grades will suffer because of this distance learning and i can't even use the credit/no credit system. neither can every single person I've asked.

Just is going to take some getting used to. Easily able to miscommunicate.

It feels massively disconnected. Which, obviously, is the point of it. However, it's not a suitable learning environment given the rigor of courses.

Bad connection hinders online class sessions and makes it hard to understand

Some professors are sending in the normal amount of work for the class. But without additional instruction, no video lecture or meeting for questions. And while you are available to ask them questions. Attempting to do the same amounts of work along with all the other classes also giving assignments when they would normally just have class feels overwhelming

the expectations are very high and there is way more work now than we had when in class which i don't think is appropriate. professors read off powerpoints i don't know why they don't post those instead of 20 readings and videos.

I like being in a class. It is easier for me to be attentive as well as do better at learning. I am not a fan of distance learning.

It's sometimes difficult to read the board when being instructed.

Same projects due but harder to complete now that we are off campus

Professors need to be trained more and though I can help out it shouldn't be up to me to do that

Not taking into account that people have a bunch of other projects going on and that we cannot drop everything to move our schedules around

It is difficult to study with the materials given- online textbooks, narrated powerpoints. Professors are distracted during their lectures by their pets

I'm just being told to read articles, read powerpoints. It's not interactive and not used to this versus having it explained in class

Too much reading on my own. Not enough engagement or interaction

It is really difficult to learn general chemistry with the current method. We are just using voice recordings that go with supplemented powerpoint slides. I personally learn better by watching the professor physically write on the board and walk us through problems and complicated topics. I am struggling with staying engaged when I don't see my professor or classmates and instead have to rely solely on voice-over recordings. That being said, the recordings are detailed and my professor has made it clear that they are "here" (via email) to answer any questions. However, it is still difficult to efficiently explain my questions over email. But I really do appreciate their efforts with this.

I am paying for in person teaching and am now doing all my classes online. If i wanted to do online classes i would have went to a junior college

Virtual learning is not as engaging. The professors are doing wonderful at trying to adapt, but it's not the same. I feel disconnected from my courses.

The fact that this is my only option. I don't do well without traditional settings. I failed the only online course I ever tried to take.

I need in person interaction

I'm a theatre major. It's a bit difficult to do literally anything at a distance.

What about the instructional methods is less than satisfying?

being just given a powerpoint. no verbal instruction. bombarded with emails about meeting times and assignments. can't keep up. nothing is in one place

Many teachers think that online learning is an excuse to add more work for the students

The wifi isn't great, the volume often cuts off or everything becomes blurry, or I even get disconnected from the classroom and it can take 15 minutes for the teacher to notice and let me back in

Audio/video quality of the chosen programs

The loss of face to face instruction with professors and the idea that some professors are trying to fulfill course requirements by doubling the amount of papers and readings assigned.

So many people on a video call gets really distracting and is difficult to do

Professor Horwitz has not gone to online teaching. He is instead just sending powerpoint and readings. His lectures are awesome and I would love for him to be able to continue, but I fear he just doesn't know how to use zoom or google so he is choosing not too. I think this will greatly hinder my class.

Notes given only in pdf format aren't really beneficial to learning. We (or at least I) have to put in at least 4+ more hours a day studying to learn what we learned in class before and the uncertainty in our professors reflects on us too. I worry about my grade.

It's hard with prerecorded lectures if you have questions to ask. You can write them down, but video calls are hard for explanation. Not the university's fault, just an unfortunate situation.

I paid for in person instruction not online instruction

The biggest problem I have faced is the amount of information/assignments that have been added on- I have received handfuls of emails each day with new assignments and things to do, the assignments we are being given do not mirror the assignments we would have in class and they have become not only extremely time consuming but also feel like busy work/just something for us to be doing. It is getting very hard to keep up with all my new assignments because I have multiple due for each class each day we meet- I understand I am not physically in class so this is supplementing missing those hours but it is overwhelming and there are only so many hours in each day. I am spending my days from 8 AM to 10/11:00 PM completing assignments/watching documentaries and writing reflections to those/virtual meetings/etc- which is very different from a normal school day. I have one class in particular that has multiple different platforms to use and it has become confusing- we started out our class 'meeting' in gmail (refreshing our email at 2:00 for an assignment) then emailing 'reply all' to send in that assignment, when that was done the professor sent us over to a created Facebook page to respond to an article that was earlier posted on Moodle-just a bit confusing. I understand there are so many moving parts for all of this, and it is an adjustment for myself as well as the professors- but everything feels both overwhelming and underwhelming at the same time.

Just everything because I just do not learn this way, I need daily lectures to fully grasp the material and right now I am not getting that.

It seems professors are adding additional work to make up for the fact that we are not seeing them in person. Also, some professors have been requesting to meet at times that are not even scheduled class times which is all together disrespectful to ask that of us. Also, it's difficult in general to get classes and class work done while home because different responsibilities are required of us while we are at home.

The impersonality but that's unavoidable under these circumstances

There are sometimes delays and technical difficulties with certain video chats

Now that is kinda on my own time to do some courses

My teacher is very old and not good at using zoom. It's too hard to learn. Another teacher has pile don the work which I find unfair.

Google hangout sessions are frustrating

Costume construction was never made to be an online course.

I feel very disconnected from my professors and feel that they are expecting a lot from us without truly touching base with us. I think it is really hard to just be given slides and be expected to teach ourselves and then be tested over it.

the teachers can't collect all their thoughts and share them in one class session or email. instead i get about 10 emails per day concerning different classes and it's extremely stressful

Hard to learn with just written notes given and no other learning methods. That is one of my courses but an important one.

Directions are sometimes unclear and confusing

Only one of my classes is through zoom which I enjoy because it feels like I'm in the classroom but my other 3 classes we are just given videos and homework and I feel slightly confused about what I'm expected to do and it is difficult to teach myself some of the concepts just by looking at powerpoints.

Moodle is a bit confusing to navigate sometimes and google meet doesn't always connect good

I struggle to learn and retain information in settings that are not based on lectures and discussions because I learn through listening and talking with others. I understand that it is difficult to coordinate online lectures and such, but I worry that moving online will affect my work quality due to how I learn.

Having everything online lessens my ability to focus even more than usual. Assignments online where we just complete questions and submit it are very boring and not educational.

It seems like the professors do not care when everything is asynchronous learning and they are abandoning face to face teaching altogether. For some classes I understand, but when the discussion classes just ask us to submit questions and such it seems silly. For something like English discussions are supposed to be thought provoking and challenge ideas, but now I feel like I am in an echo chamber just saying my thoughts into the void. I could read scientific articles by myself before this semester and that is all some classes are doing now.

The requirement for us all to teach ourselves our work (for the most part) while doing the same (in some cases, MORE) coursework than previous is incredibly intense. It's taking days to get lessons read and assignments done. The fact that professors are updating us sometimes last-minute, usually in multiple disjointed emails, is not helping anything. Communications are difficult, and the constant flood of e-mails is getting confusing and stressful, especially on top of having all this coursework due.

One of my professors has not been communicating well and the expectations for students are confusing

just getting used to work at home

Lectures via Zoom are extremely difficult to see/hear with spotty internet

Google hangout and Zoom are simply insufficient compared to the in person education I'm used to. My classes don't translate well to this format and I wish more professors would prepare a lecture as a video to send out.

Less engagement with classmates and professors, less structure because some classes don't meet, it feels like a vacation so it's harder to engage, etc

I narrated slide presentation is not sufficient. As a student we have to create an environment suitable to learn; therefore, each professor needs to make their environment suitable to do live streams of class.

Its hard for art classes and there are no demos or examples. no materials

Some professors seem to be having a lot of trouble switching to online. One of my professors in particular insists we conduct class over a Moodle forum, which is extremely inefficient.

A lot of assignments/due dates/expectations are not clear

Hard to understand professors when they pre-record lectures with no videos

Higher learning is an immersive experience that causes us to synthesize the knowledge we are taking on in an elaborate and enabling way. Currently, we exist in a very isolated environment. As a senior nursing student, I also find myself grieving while under a lot of simultaneous pressure to perform.

I can't concentrate because I'm living in a quarantined pandemic. Because we aren't having lectures, my professors are giving me more homework. I now have more stress from this homework load on top of my stress from this global pandemic.

Making YouTube videos. Having an online lecture is much better because then we can ask questions and know what is expected of us for that day. Additionally, having online lectures allows for actual time restraints instead of putting an entire chapter on YouTube which we could have never covered in a week. Also, exams that are heavily timed are very annoying as many different computer related issues can occur that makes it hard to finish a one hour exam in an hour.

We are paying tuition to watch videos

Some of my instructors are not using Moodle or other websites to their full capabilities, meaning I'm missing out on information and the experiences I had at IWU.

Some classes are all simply notes and assignments without engaging lectures or activities which come with a classroom setting

I understand that this is beyond our control, but just merely calling and discussing topics is not enough for me. I miss the physical classroom where we can do activities together along with discussing.

Hard to ask questions and work through problems over the phone.

1) Some Professors want to work outside the assigned times 2) Most Professors are confused and the direct contact creates wrong interpretations in relation to our expectations

I think the professors should try to mimic their classroom as much as possible; I see that some professors are just talking and hovering a mouse over a PDF. That is not how I am used to learning. It would be nice if they could use an iPad or virtual whiteboard to mimic writing on the whiteboard like in the classroom. Find ways to get used to doing exercises like in class and shareout. I find myself teaching myself and learning from youtube videos and additional resources that I previously did not need before.

The quality of teaching doesn't compare to the quality on campus.

The lack of in person social interaction, as well as the sheer panic of the economy right now makes this learning method less than satisfying.

It causes professors to go way to fast

Presentations will be extremely tedious to do

Too much work so I am forced to charge my phone two times and work from my phone all day.

I am basically self teaching in 3 classes as they are not holding zoom/google hangouts/online lectures. It honesty sucks.

For languages, it is very difficult to understand what people are saying over the video calling services that are being used. This makes it harder to be engaged with the language and so I am having trouble learning and understanding material.

Its hard to focus and sometimes hard to understand whats happening because voices will cut in and out and video will lower in resolution to the point where its impossible to decipher anything

As an education major, any instructional method used that is not face-to-face is not very effective.

I think for certain classes, beyond discussion based classes, this digital format makes lecture extremely more difficult. For example, science or math based classes that focus largely on lecture.

What about the instructional methods is less than satisfying?

We are not being taught anything and have more homework than ever.

I don't think the price tag of the university is at all justified for this situation on hand. The fact that most, if not all, of the learning is being done independently makes it seem like we're paying for a name and not the education.

There is less personal connections with professors, there is no teaching happening, only assignments being given.

None of my classes are doing online lecture. They just gave us material and deadlines to learn it.

Not thrilled about spending 2x as much time on schoolwork as normal.

Professors are assigning more papers and assignments to be done in a short amount of time.

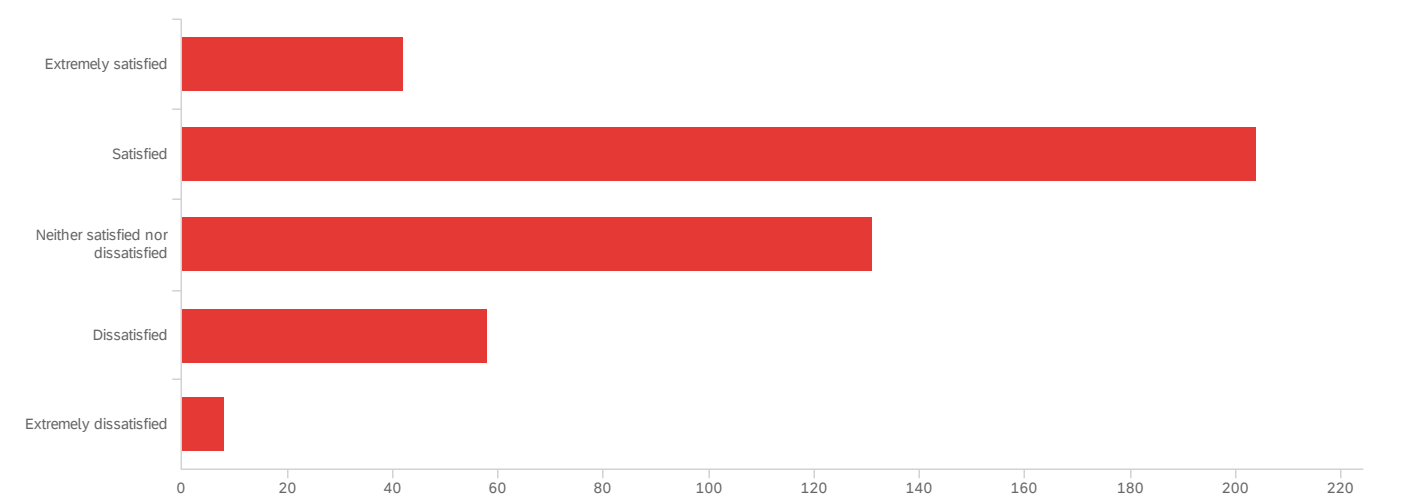
Theatre classes are very hard to do online and get the whole experience

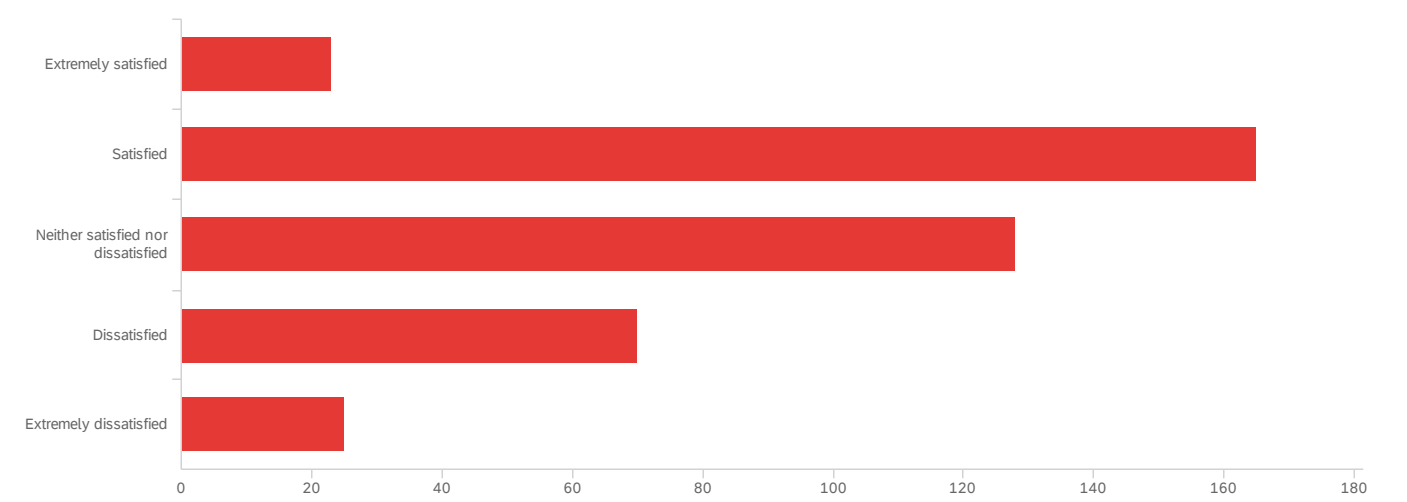

Honestly I think students talk less to each other in the class discussions via video chat than when we were face to face in class

Many of my classes are discussion based, but through a computer, it's harder to interact in group settings. My professors are experimenting with group chats, but that also requires knowledge about our programs and technology, which they are working through but is still a learning process for them as well.

In some classes I am not as close to other students compared to other classes. Thus, if I want to talk to another student questions about an assignment, I have to get creative and find means to reach out to someone. I'm not sure how to fix it, but it has only been a minor issue.

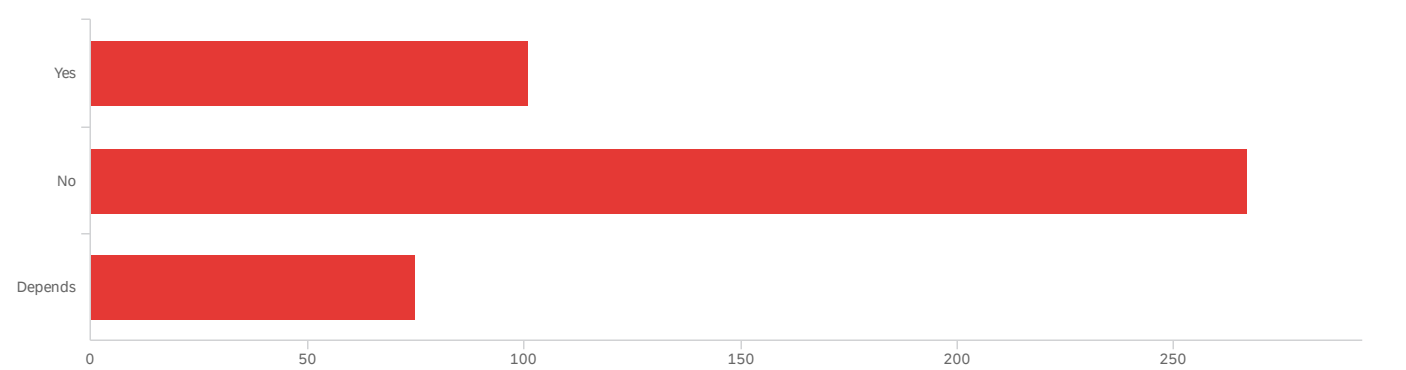
