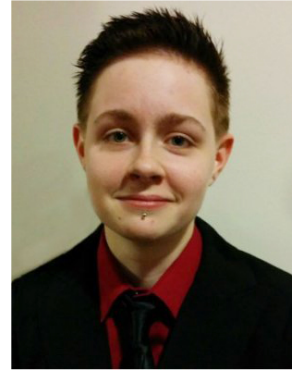
Amerson '17 Wins "Emerging Leader" Scholarship

BLOOMINGTON, Ill.— Illinois Wesleyan University student Autumn Amerson '17 (Libertyville, Ill.) has been awarded an Emerging Leaders Award from the National Society of Leadership and Success. The financial award was made to Amerson for her leadership ability and accomplishments.
